
Teaching Guide

The Believer's Prayer Book (A Study of Psalms)

Study Beginning March 2026

Many Christians struggle with how to pray and what to pray. The book of Psalms provides the individual believer and the church a guide on how to praise, petition, and proclaim our Lord God. There are psalms of thanksgiving and joy, frustration and fear, cries for help and forgiveness, and psalms of praise to the always faithful God Almighty who hears His people's prayers and offers the encouragement, discipline, forgiveness, and comfort that each person needs.

The 150 psalms contained in the book of Psalms span the emotional and circumstantial gamut from joy, hope, elation, sadness, despair, guilt, frustration, anger and fear. Since God inspired the composers' words of these psalms, He enjoys hearing His divinely inspired words and ideas being communicated back to Him. Not merely reading the Psalms but praying them to God as if they were one's own feelings and circumstances allows the believer to share with God one's innermost thoughts, vulnerabilities, hopes, and trust in the Creator. We hope this study of fifteen psalms will help you **grow stronger in your prayer life and relationship with the Lord.**

GC2 Strong

A Great Commandment & Great Commission Awakening (A Biblical Theme Study)

Study Beginning June 2026

What would it look like for a person—or a whole church—to become GC2 Strong?

GC2 is short for two commands Jesus never meant to separate:

- The Great Commandment: Love God with all your heart, soul, and mind—and love your neighbor as yourself (Matthew 22:37–40).
- The Great Commission: Go make disciples—baptizing and teaching people to obey what Jesus taught (Matthew 28:18–20).

Most churches believe these are true. But it's easy to drift into "we agree with that" instead of "we live like that"—good intentions without real obedience.

God didn't give Jesus' words for us to admire from a distance. He gave them to shape how we live every day. That's why GC2 Strong is a call to wake up to **Great Love and Great Mission**—and to live at the intersection of both.

GC2 Strong is a 13-session Bible study built for real churches. Each session helps believers grow in love for God, love for people, and a clear commitment to disciple-making—so the church doesn't just know the mission, but lives it.

(A Study of Romans)

Study Beginning September 2026


Following a treacherous sea voyage, replete with a shipwreck, Acts reports in a rather anti-climactic, matter of fact manner that Paul and his companions “came to Rome” (28:14, 16). The title of this study of Paul’s famed letter to the Romans is a play upon that turn of phrase.

As it happens, Romans follows Acts in the New Testament canon. Though significantly shorter in length than Acts, Romans is the longest letter composed by Paul that has been preserved for our instruction and inspiration.

And instruct and inspire it does! Generations of Christians have turned to Romans, a “weighty and strong letter” (see 2 Corinthians 10:10), to learn of salvation through and of life in Christ. In this 13-week study, we will journey through Romans from beginning to end section by section. Having done so, we have a fuller grasp of how this letter flows and what this letter teaches, and we, in turn, will rejoice and be glad that **we came to Romans**.

Encountering Jesus in the Gospel of John

(A Study of John)

Study Beginning December 2026

What happens when people truly encounter Jesus? **Come and See** invites you to explore the Gospel of John as a story of discovery, belief, and life-changing faith. John’s Gospel draws readers into a series of encounters—moments where ordinary people meet Jesus and are confronted with who He truly is. Through signs, conversations, and bold claims, this study challenges you to move beyond information to transformation and to follow Jesus with confidence and purpose.

John wrote his Gospel so that you might believe that Jesus is the Messiah, the Son of God, and that by believing you may have life in His name. Unlike the other Gospels, John slows down to focus on key moments that reveal Jesus’ identity—turning water into wine, healing the blind, raising the dead, and speaking words that cut straight to the heart. From the opening declaration that the Word became flesh to the final call to believe, John presents Jesus as the light who enters the darkness and offers true life. This study follows John’s unique witness, helping you see who Jesus is, why belief matters, and how **an encounter with Him reshapes the way you live**.

Nehemiah was an unlikely choice to lead a team to rebuild Jerusalem's walls. He was cupbearer for King Artaxerxes, living in the Persian capital, Susa. He had a prestigious place of influence serving the king. Why would he jeopardize the security of his position for a risky and dangerous task? Yet Nehemiah never forgot Jerusalem, nor the God of Israel. Nehemiah is a historical book including lessons on leadership and dependence on prayer. He was one who relentlessly pursued the will of God, and these 13 lessons will encourage us to pursue God's will also.

What are characteristics of true disciples? Is discipleship only for the original disciples of the New Testament? What is evangelism? Is evangelism a gift, calling or position within the church? 
STANDING BY HIS WORD GOD FULFILLS HIS PROMISES
